## Gulf Island Hopper Expedition

The Gulf Islands are a unique archipelago of Mediterranean like islands situated on the south east coast of Vancouver Island. Intricate honeycombed sandstone cliffs, clamshell beaches and spectacular bird watching (bald eagles, oyster catchers, turkey vultures and cormorants, just to name a few) are just some of the amazing qualities this area has to offer. Swathed in history with tales of the Aquarian Foundation, buried gold and Brother XII's whip wielding consort Madame Zee! These mini-archipelagos rival the West Coast for unique scenery, aboriginal history and abundant wildlife; they should not be overlooked as a kayaking adventure destination!

<b>Day 0</b>	Arriving on Vancouver Island
	<b>The day before your trip starts</b> Your Gulf Island Hopper expedition begins with a "Day 0". This is the day that you should try and arrive on Vancouver Island. For example, when the brochure trip date is July 10 <sup>th</sup> you should arrive on Vancouver Island on July 9 <sup>th</sup> . Day 0 is really meant for international travel and getting to Vancouver Island.
<b>Day 1</b>	Kayaking and wildlife viewing
	We will depart from Nanaimo at 06:30 a.m. From there we will travel to Cedar by the Sea, our launch point. At the launch site our guides will discuss kayaking safety principles and then we will depart for historic Pirates Cove on DeCourcey Island and enjoy a delicious salmon dinner. <b>Accommodation: Camping</b>
<b>Day 2</b>	Kayak the Gulf Islands Archipelago
	After an early breakfast we will pack our kayaks to explore the coastlines of Ruxton, Pylades and Whaleboat Islands. Along the way we will be keeping an eye out for bald eagles, oyster catchers, turkey vultures, seals and sea lions and more..... <b>Accommodation: Camping</b>
<b>Day 3</b>	Our final day
	We will rise early to the aroma of freshly brewed coffee and a yummy breakfast. After breaking camp we will take a leisurely paddle back up the coastline to our launch at Cedar, enjoying lunch along the way. We will arrive back at the launch at approximately 13:30 hrs, allowing sufficient time for connections and travel.

This is also where you will find the mandatory liability waiver form, detailed registration and medical forms.
