Nuchatlitz Wild West Coast Expedition

Our Nuchatlitz Expedition takes place in one of the best kayaking destinations in the world! Situated on the northwest coast of Nootka Island (the largest island on the west coast of Vancouver Island), the Nuchatlitz archipelago and inlet offers paddling beyond compare! Large rafts of sea otters are not a rarity in this area, as it is home to one of the largest otter populations in the world. The area is also rich with natural predators (black bears, bald eagles, wolves and more...) creating abundant wildlife and photographic opportunities.

Day 0	Arriving on Vancouver Island
	The day before your trip starts Your Nuchatlitz Expedition begins with a "Day 0". This is the day that you should arrive on Vancouver Island. If the trip date is August 13 ^h you should arrive on Vancouver Island on August 12 th . Day 0 is really meant for international travel and getting to Vancouver Island.
Day 1	Travel to Launch
	We will depart from Port McNeill traveling for approximately 2 1/2 hrs to our west destination of Zeballos. At the launch site our guides will discuss kayaking safety principles and then we will depart, paddling through Little Espinoza Inlet to our first campsite at Garden Point. Here we will settle in for the evening and enjoy a delicious salmon dinner as we watch the setting sun. Accommodation: Camping
Day 2	Kayaking
	After a hearty breakfast prepared by your guides, we will pack up camp and set out on our exploration of this remote and wild section of the west coast! Letting the ever-present tides and currents assist us on our journey, we will travel in our kayaks enjoying the natural splendor of this magical area. Sea otters are prevalent here, so we will no doubt spend time watching these entertaining creatures feed and play! Evening will find us at a new campsite enjoying another delectable dinner and relaxing by the campfire. Accommodation: Camping
Day 3,4,5	Kayaking
	Over the next several days we will venture further into the archipelago, exploring the rugged west coast environment. We will soak in the solitude of this remote area as we encounter the abundant wildlife. Keep a close eye out for black bears on the beaches; they are wonderful to watch from the vantage point of a kayak! We will spend our evenings on one of the many spectacular beaches in the area enjoying hot drinks and a campfire as we bring each day to a close. Accommodation: Camping
Day 6	Kayaking
	Today as we paddle back through the archipelago, we will take time to once again watch the playful sea otters and explore the small islands on our way to camp. We will also have plenty of time to cruise for wildlife, explore the intertidal zone for critters and capture photographs. We will set up camp on Garden Point to enjoy our final evening of this wild west coast adventure! Accommodation: Camping
Day 7	Departure Day
	After an early, hearty breakfast we will break camp and set out down Little Espinoza Inlet to our original launch point. Here we will enjoy our final lunch, say our farewells to those not traveling with us, and depart on our trip home to Port McNeill making stops as requested along the way.
