## Vargas Island Voyager Expedition

The Vargas Island Voyager expedition combines the best of what Clayoquot Sound has to offer in two nights of camping on expansive sandy beaches followed by a final night of soothing relaxation nestled snugly in the jewel of Clayoquot Sound, the Inn at Vargas Island. We will spend four breathtaking days kayaking, exploring, feasting and learning about this unique area that was designated a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve in 2000. We will have the opportunity to visit the sandy expanses of the outer beaches, explore intertidal zones filled with astonishing sea creatures and visit remarkable Meares Island; home of the Big Tree Trail.

<b>Day 1</b>	<b>Arriving on Vancouver Island</b>
	You'll begin your trip at the launch site in the friendly, world famous community of Tofino. You can travel with us in the WeGo van from Port McNeill or meet us at the launch site at 12:30 hrs. Here, we will make the transfer to our kayaks and, after a boat packing and safety lesson, begin our journey.

<b>Day 2</b>	<b>Kayaking</b>
	An early breakfast and hot coffee before setting off for some morning paddling along the exposed coast of Vargas Island. We will lunch on one of the beautiful sandy beaches, taking time to capture photographs of the abundant wildlife.
	<b>Accommodation: Camping</b>
<b>Day 3</b>	<b>Kayaking &amp; stay at Vargas lodge</b>
	Today we will make our way to Meares Island (site of the largest environmental protest in Canadian history) to hike among the giant ancient Cedars of the Big Tree Trail. After stretching our legs we will return to our kayaks and paddle to the Inn at Vargas Island to relax and enjoy dinner, and maybe a hot sauna to sooth those tired muscles...!
	<b>Accommodation: Vargas Lodge</b>
<b>Day 4</b>	<b>Departure day</b>
	After a leisurely breakfast we will break camp and commence our paddle back to the place it all began, the village of Tofino. In Tofino we will enjoy a hearty lunch before we board the WeGo van for our trip back down Vancouver Island.
