Wild Orca Discovery Expedition

On our Wild Orca Discovery expedition we offer a comfortable base camping experience utilizing two sites. Our newest site located on Hanson Island is positioned for optimal viewing of the Orca, Humpback and Minke whales as they forage, sleep and play. Our Maggie Point outpost camp; the only base camp within the islands of the Broughton Archipelago Marine Park, offers paddling in an area world-renowned for its rich native culture in addition to viewing of the whales and other wildlife. Enjoy an experience unlike any other, camping has never been this good!

Day 0	Arriving on Vancouver Island
	Day 0 is meant for travelling to Vancouver island on the Sunday before the start of the expedition. Upon your arrival in Port McNeill, we will meet at the Haida Way Inn at 19:00 hrs to join your fellow travellers and guides, and discuss the upcoming expedition.
Day 1	Kayaking and Orca viewing
	This expedition commences from Port McNeill in the morning when you board our high-speed water taxi for a scenic voyage through the emerald green waters of the Inside Passage. After settling into our campsite the guides will conduct a kayak safety lesson and then we will venture out and try our new skills!

Day 2	Kayaking and Orca viewing
	We start off the day with a hearty breakfast prepared with great care by your guides. Whale watching will be our priority today and we will keep our ears and eyes open for any news of whales in the area. By staying in touch with our network of whale researchers and watchers by way of our marine radios, we will be sure to have the best opportunities to encounter whales, porpoises or dolphins that may be in our vicinity. When the opportunity arises, the guides will use a hydrophone so we can listen in on the whale conversations taking place below us!

Day 3	Change base camp day
	After an early rise and packing up our personal belongings, we will enjoy breakfast and then set out on our journey to the second outpost camp. While we enjoy the day, observing whales, wildlife and the rugged coastline, all of our personal gear will be moved and set up at our new base camp by our camp managers. When we arrive at the second camp all you have to do is settle in and enjoy your new surroundings!

Day 4	Kayaking the broughton archipelago
	Today will be spent exploring our new location looking for whales and other wildlife, as well as immersing ourselves in the native cultural aspects of the area. There are culturally significant sites to see here along with beautiful sheltered paddling in the Broughton archipelago.

Day 5	Departure day
	After another hearty breakfast, we will begin our last paddle, peeking into Blackfish Sound for a final soul stirring visit with the whales before heading back to the base camp for lunch and preparation for our water taxi pick up at 16:00 hrs to return to Port McNeill.
